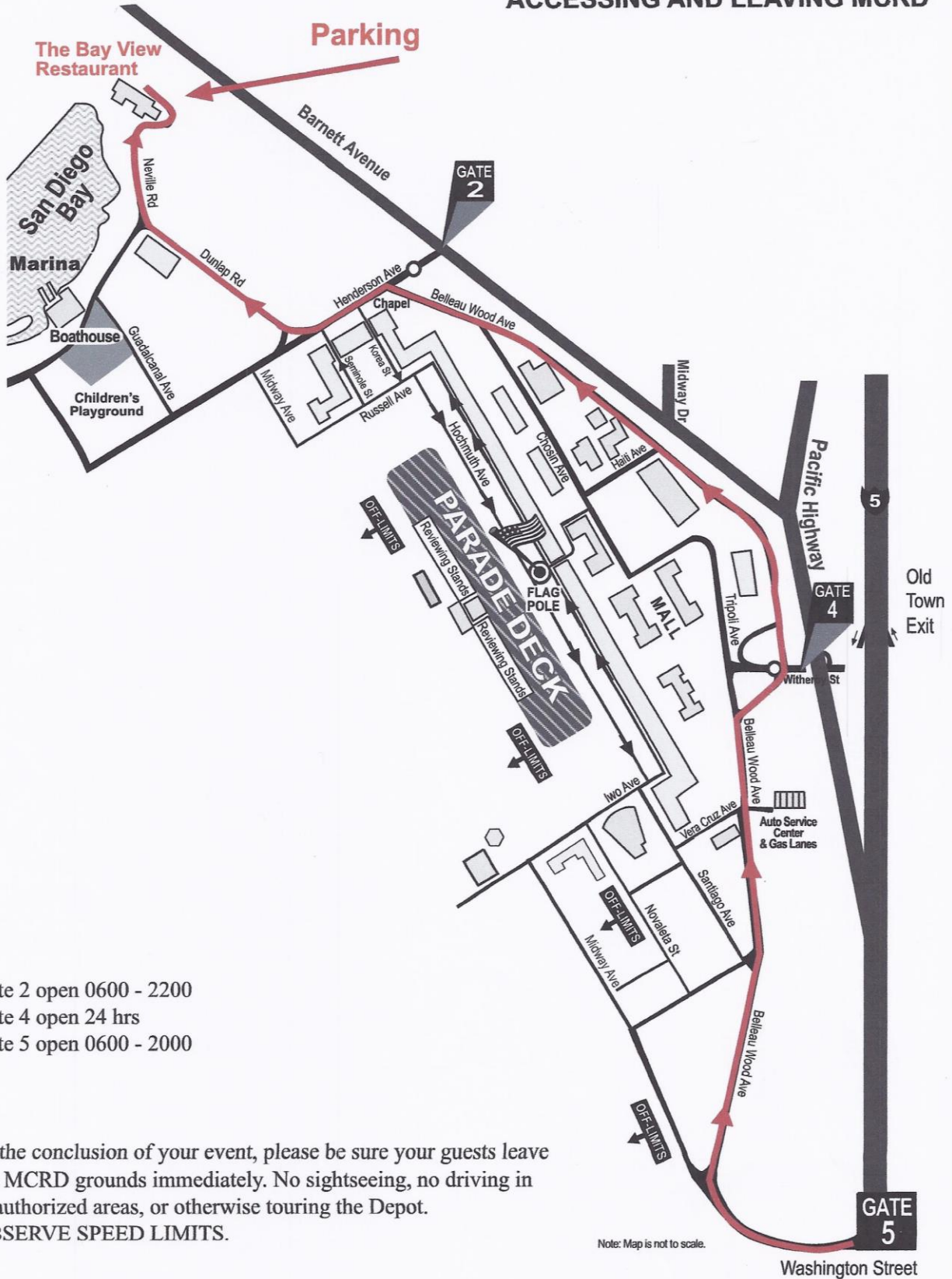

ACCESSING AND LEAVING MCRD



Gate 2 open 0600 - 2200

DIRECTIONS

The Marine Corps Recruit Depot (MCRD) is located just northwest of downtown San Diego, west of Interstate 5 and south of Interstate 8. All guests of MCRD Bay View Restaurant are instructed to use Gate 5. See your Catering Sales Representative for details.

ENTERING AND LEAVING THE DEPOT:

Vehicle driver must show valid driver's license to the Military Policeman at gate before entering the Depot. The driver may be asked to show car registration and proof of car insurance. All occupants of vehicles must be wearing seat belts. The MP will direct you to the Bay View Restaurant. The speed limit throughout the base is 20 MPH. No cell phone use allowed while driving a vehicle on base.

TRAVELING FROM THE NORTH:

Drive south on Interstate 5. Take the Washington Street exit. At traffic light turn right onto the MCRD Gate 5.

TRAVELING FROM THE SOUTH:

Drive north on Interstate 5. Take the Washington Street exit. Turn left on Washington Street and continue straight ahead to MCRD Gate 5.

TRAVELING FROM THE EAST:

Drive I-8 West to I-5 South. Take the Washington Street exit. At traffic light turn right to MCRD Gate 5.

TRAVELING FROM THE WEST (Point Loma):

From Rosecrans Street in Point Loma, turn right onto Lytton Street; Lytton becomes Barnett Avenue. Drive past MCRD Gate 2 and Gate 4. Continue south, stay in right lane and turn right on Washington Street which will take you to MCRD Gate 5.

DEPARTURE:

Gate 2 open 0600 - 2200

Gate 4 open 24 hrs

Gate 5 open 0600 - 2000

PLEASE NOTE:

Prevailing security conditions at MCRD may cause changes to the above gate openings and closing.

All guests traveling to MCRD Bay View Restaurant are instructed to use MCRD Gate 5. Your guests must have appropriate photo I.D. and will be asked to show it to Military Police. The driver may be asked to show car registration and proof of car insurance. After your event, your guests must leave the Depot immediately.

No sightseeing, joy-riding or otherwise touring the depot are permitted. See your catering sales representative for further details.
